

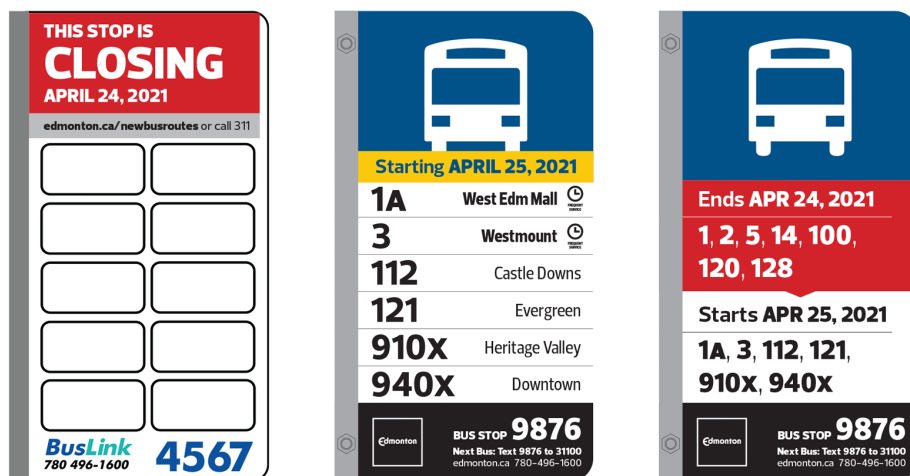

## Introducing Edmonton Transit Service's new bus stop signs

In preparation for the changing bus network and new bus routes that start on **April 25, 2021**, City of Edmonton crews are installing and updating signs at the City's 7,000 bus stops. This work will take several months, which is why the signs are going up now.

**Current bus routes and schedules do not change until April 25 next year.**



When a new sign goes up, you will see one of three stickers.

routes will stop there starting **April 25, 2021**.

- New bus stop signs will have a yellow sticker to let you know it opens **April 25, 2021**.
- Closing bus stops will keep their existing signs and a red sticker will be applied to the top of it to let you know it is closed after **April 24, 2021**.
- Closing bus stops in [On Demand Transit](#) areas will keep their existing signs and a red sticker will be applied to the top of it to let you know that regular service ends on **April 24, 2021** and On Demand Transit service begins on **April 25, 2021**. Note: On Demand Transit pick-up locations are still being finalized and may not be at existing bus stops.
